STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

No. 4 of 1994

Income Tax (Amendment) Regulation 1994

Being

A Regulation to amend the Income Tax Regulation 1959,

MADE by the Head of State, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council under the *Income Tax Act* 1959.

1. INDUSTRIES AND RURAL AREAS PRESCRIBED FOR THE PURPOSES OF DIVISION III.1B (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 6AA).

Section 6AA of the Principal Regulation is amended by repealing Subsection (1) (b) and replacing it with the following:—

"(b) commercial activities falling within major Tabulation Categories of the International Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities published in 1990 under Revision 3:—

- (i) Tabulation Category D — Manufacturing;
- (ii) Tabulation Category F — Construction;
- (iii) Tabulation Category I — Transport, Storage and Communication;
- (iv) Tabulation Category O — Other Community, Social and Personal Service Activities;
- (v) Tabulation Category J — Financial intermediation;
- (vi) Tabulation Category K — Real estate, renting and business activities."

2. HOW TAX MAY BE PAID (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 43).

Section 43 of the Principal Regulation is amended:—

(a) by adding the following new paragraph:—

"(e) where there has been an assignment by the State pursuant to Section 11A of the *Mineral Resources Stabilisation Fund Act* (Chapter 194), by payment by telegraphic transfer, cheque or bank draft made directly to the assignee."; and

(b) by adding the following new Subsections:—

"(2) The Commissioner General may direct that any tax payable under the Act is to be paid in a currency other than Kina.

"(3) The payment of the foreign currency equivalent at the market rate on the date of payment shall be a lawful discharge of the taxpayer's obligation to pay the tax."
