DECLARATION OF NATIONAL EMERGENCY

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 228(1) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby declare the existence of a National Emergency in relation to the East New Britain Province with effect from 19th September, 1994.

Emergency (General Powers) Regulation 1994

APPOINTMENT OF CONTROLLER

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Emergency (General Powers) Regulation 1994 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby appoint—

- (a) the Director of the National Disaster Centre to be the Controller; and
- (b) the person appointed under Section 50 of the Organic Law on Provincial Government to act in relation to East New Britain Province to be the Deputy Controller; and
- (c) Colonel Eric Ani to be an Assistant Controller,

for the purposes of the Emergency (General Powers) Regulation 1994.
