*Public Finances (Management) Act, 1986***NATIONAL EDUCATION SUPPLY AND TENDERS BOARD**

I, John Tekwie, Vice Minister for Finance and Planning, by virtue of the powers conferred by the *Public Finances (Management) Act, 1986* as amended and all other powers me enabling, hereby

- (a) in accordance with Section 39 of the *Public Finances (Management) Act, 1986*:—
  - (i) establish a supply and tenders board to be known as the National Education Supply and Tenders Board;
  - (ii) the composition of the National Education Supply and Tenders Board shall be as per enclosed Schedule;
  - (iii) direct that the purpose of the Board is to control and regulate the purchase and disposal of property and stores and the supply of works and services for and on behalf of the State (National Department of Education);
  - (iv) direct that the board shall have authority to approve up to a million kina and a half (K1.5 million) projects and purchase of goods and services. However, where the project is to be funded under a loan, the board shall have authority to approve up to three million (K3 million) projects, purchases of materials, textbooks, stores.
- (b) for the better operation of the board, issue the following rules:—
  - (i) the quorum at a meeting of the Board shall be not less than three voting members;
  - (ii) a minimum of three voting members of the Board indicated in the Schedule shall make the final decision of the Board by voting;
  - (iii) the fifth (5) member shown in the Schedule shall only attend the Board meetings where capital works are to be considered;
  - (iv) the Board shall invite tenders necessary for the efficient operation of the Education Department, for:—
    - (a) the purchase and disposal of stores, equipment, textbooks;
    - (b) the supply of capital works and maintenance;
    - (c) the supply of works and services;
    - (d) the commissioning of consultants to provide technical services on behalf of the State of a value estimated by the Board not exceeding the amount specified.
  - (v) the board shall adhere to the requirements prescribed by the Financial Institutions in relation to the tender procedures; and
  - (vi) a decision will be binding as long as a simple majority of members of the Board are in its favour.

## National Education Supply and Tenders Board—Continued

- (c) appoint each person specified in Column 2 of the Schedule to be the alternate members to those in Column 1; that in the event of the absence of a member of the Board from a meeting of the Board or his inability for any reason to act in relation to a matter, his alternate has and may exercise and perform all his powers and functions for that meeting or in relation to that matter.
