*Fauna (Protection and Control) Act (Chapter 154)***DECLARATION OF TAVALO WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA AND RULES AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF TAVALO WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

I, Robert Sakias, Minister for Environment, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 15 and 16 of the *Fauna (Protection and Control) Act* (Chapter 154) and all other powers me enabling, having consulted with the owners of the land described in Schedule 1, hereby—

- (a) declare the land described in Schedule 1 to be a Wildlife Management Area to be known as Tavalu Wildlife Management Area for the purpose of that Act; and
- (b) establish a Wildlife Management Committee for that Wildlife Management Area; and
- (c) specify that the number of members of the Committee to be 7; and
- (d) appoint each person specified in Schedule 2 to be a member of that committee.

SCHEDULE

All that piece of land which is located approximately between Tavalu River to the East and Mukus River to the West, covering an area of approximately 20.0 square kilometres of land and sea commencing on the High Water Mark (H.W.M) at Position South Latitude 6 degrees 1 minute east longitude 150 degrees 52 minutes 10 seconds thence inland due northwest for 2.5 kilometres to the second point at position south latitude 6 degrees 10 seconds east longitude 150 degrees 51 minutes thence turning east eastward for 1.2 kilometres to the third point at position south latitudes 5 degrees 59 minutes east longitudes 150 degrees 51 minutes 30 seconds thence turning southeast for 2.85 kilometres to the next point on the H.W.M at position south latitude degrees 40 seconds east longitude 150 degrees 52 minutes 50 seconds thence turning further eastward along the H.W.M for 2.5 kilometres to a point on the mouth of Tavalu River at Position south latitude 6 degrees 30 seconds east longitude 150 degrees 54 minutes 10 seconds thence directly due south 4.0 kilometres into Solomon sea at Position south latitude 6 degrees 2 minutes 40 seconds east longitude 150 degrees 54 minutes 10 seconds thence turning directly due West for 5.0 kilometres to the next position in the Solomon Sea, being south latitude 6 degrees 2 minutes 40 seconds east longitude 150 degrees 51 minutes 20 seconds thence directly due north for 2.5 kilometres towards the shore at a point on the H.W.M approximately 1.5 kilometres east of the mouth of Mukus River at Position south latitude 6 degrees 1 minute 20 seconds east longitude 150 degrees 51 minutes 20 seconds thence eventually following the H.W.M. a further 1.5 kilometres eastward closing back at its commencement and original point.

*National Housing Corporation Act 1990***DECLARATION OF SPECIAL CATEGORY OF HOUSES AND SPECIFICATION OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE**

I, Robert Nagle, Minister for Housing, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 42 (1) and (2) of the *National Housing Corporation Act 1990* and all other powers me enabling:—

- (a) declare the houses on the properties specified in Column 2 of Schedule 2 as Special Category of Houses to which Section 41 of the said Act does not apply; and
- (b) specify that the terms and conditions under which the special category of houses are to be given away under the Give Away Scheme approved by the National Executive Council Decision No. NG 78(1)/92 are specified in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The National Housing Corporation shall transfer the properties specified in Column 2 of Schedule 2 to the persons specified in Column 1, subject to each satisfying the requirements of "an Approved Transferee" under the terms and conditions of the Give Away Scheme.

2. Subject to Paragraph 1 of this Schedule, the Corporation shall enter into a contract of sale with each person specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 which shall include the following terms and conditions:—

- (a) the "Approved Transferee" shall pay all the rental arrears.
- (b) the "Approved Transferee" shall continue to pay rental fixed by the National Housing Corporation until the contract of sale is executed between himself and National Housing Corporation.
- (c) that the "Approved Transferee" shall not be a beneficiary to any other Housing Scheme.
- (d) that the "Approved Transferee" shall pay the following fees:—
 - (1) The lease preparation fee (if applicable) payable to the State Lease pursuant to the *Land Act* (Chapter 185);
 - (2) Stamp duty on contract of transfer and transfer instrument;
 - (3) Valuation fee at the specified rate;
 - (4) Administration fee;
 - (5) Legal costs;
 - (6) Registration fee on transfer;
 - (7) The Minister for Lands Approval Fee; and

Declaration of Special Category of Houses and Specification of Terms and Conditions of Sale—*continued*

(e) that the "Approved Transferee" shall be responsible for payment of:—

- (1) Land rentals and land rates; and
- (2) Any other land taxes as from the date of contract of sale between the National Housing Corporation and the Approved Transferee.
