Excise Tariff Act (Chapter 107)

EXEMPTION FROM EXCISE DUTY

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3(1)(a) of the *Excise Tariff Act (Chapter 107)*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby, with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*, exempt from excise duty motor vehicles and other goods imported for use in Papua New Guinea's Silver Jubilee Celebrations, subject to the condition that the vehicles and other goods for use in those celebrations have been approved for that purpose on or before 16th September, 2000.
