GENERAL PRICES (AMENDMENT No. 3) ORDER 2000

being

A Prices Order to amend the General Prices Order 1995.

MADE by the Price Controller under the *Prices Regulation Act* (Chapter 320) to come into operation on the 1st March, 2000.

These relates to the maximum Water and Sewerage rates for all Water Supply and Sewerage Services Districts. All charges and fees (other than arrears) shown on accounts issued on or after 1st March, 2000 become due and payable to the following rates.

- Charges based on meter readings under items 1 and 2 have been set on per connection basis.
- In the case of multiple residential buildings, such as flats, dormitories, duplexes, etc., the user may apply to be charged on the basis of the non-commercial tariff 1.2 above.
- If a connection serves a mixed occupancy property, the higher tariff scale shall apply.
- All charges under items 3 and 4 must be paid in advance, unless special arrangements are made with the District Manager. All charges under items 1 and 2 must be paid within 30 days after the date of delivery of an account. Failure to pay accounts within the stipulated period will lead to service being discontinued and recovery action being taken. The user of the service and/or the owner of the property is responsible for paying bills or for ensuring that bills are paid.
- The customer is responsible for the cost of connecting to the building from the property boundary.
- For temporary new connections, the water charges will be the same as for Commercial/Industrial customers under item 1.2.
