Organic Law on the Calling of Meetings of the Parliament

FIXING OF TIME AND DATE OF MEETING OF THE PARLIAMENT

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 124 of the Constitution and Section 1 of the *Organic Law on the Calling of Meetings of the Parliament*, after consultation with the outgoing Prime Minister and Speaker, fix 10 o'clock in the forenoon of Monday 5th August, 2002 as the time and date on which the Parliament shall meet for the first time after the 2002 general election.
