Number of Ministers (Amendment of Section 1).

ORGANIC LAW ON THE NUMBER OF MINISTERS (AMENDMENT) LAW 2008

being

An Organic Law to amend the *Organic Law on the Number of Ministers*,

MADE by the National Parliament.

NUMBER OF MINISTERS (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 1)

Section 1 of the Organic Law is amended in Subsection (2) by repealing the word and figure "is 18" and substituting the following:—

"shall not exceed 32".

A Law to amend the Constitution,

MADE by the National Parliament.

OTHER MINISTERS (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 144)

Section 144 of the Constitution is amended in Subsection (1) by repealing the words “more than one quarter of the number of members of the Parliament” and substituting the following:—

“not exceeding 32”.
