## CONSTITUTION

### DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, Michael Thomas Somare, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

- (a) amend the Determination of the Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers dated 13th September, 2007 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G145 on 13th September, 2007 (as amended); and
- (b) declare that this Determination supersedes all others (including temporary determination) in so far they relate to Schedule 3 of the Determination referred to above (Minister for Works, Transport and Civil Aviation); and
- (c) determine that the Minister set out in Column 1 of the Schedule shall have—
  - (i) the title specified in Column 2; and
  - (ii) the responsibilities specified in Column 3; and
  - (iii) the responsibilities for administering the Acts (or parts of the Acts) specified in Column 4, and set out opposite the name of the Minister,

to come into effect on and from the date of signature of this instrument:
