**REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF ACTING COMMISSIONER OF POLICE  
AND ACTING DEPARTMENTAL HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF POLICE**

I, Sir Michael Ogio, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(2) of the Constitution and Section 9 of the *Police Act 1998* and Section 27 of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation of the Public Service Commission and the Permanent Parliamentary Committee on appointments, hereby —

- (a) revoke the appointment of Anthony Wagambie as Commissioner of Police and Departmental Head of the Department of Police published in the *National Gazette* No. G140 of 31st May, 2011; and
- (b) appoint Tom Kulunga as Acting Commissioner of Police and the Acting Departmental Head of the Department of Police,

with effect on and from 29th September, 2011 until further notice.
