THE Government proposes to alter the Constitution pursuant to the requirement of Section 14(2) (*making of alterations to the Constitution*) of the Constitution, I, Jeffery Nape Speaker of the National Parliament, hereby publish the proposed Law.

MADE by the National Parliament.

Part VIII, Division 1 of the Constitution is amended by adding the following new subdivision after Section 212 of Part VIII, Division 1, Subdivision A;

“Subdivision AA.—The Sovereign Wealth Fund”.

212A. SOVEREIGN WEALTH FUND.

- (1) There is established a fund to be called “Sovereign Wealth Fund”.
- (2) An *Organic Law* may make further provision in respect of the Sovereign Wealth Fund.
