### REVOCATION OF ACTING CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND APPOINTMENT OF CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

**AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS**

  - (i) in Column 3, “(d) MRDC”; and
  - (ii) in Column 4 “*Mineral Resource Development Company Pty. Limited (Privatisation) Act 1996*”;
