Employment of Non-Citizens Act 2007

REVOCATION OF THE EXEMPTION

I, Mark Maipakai, MP., Minister for Labour and Industrial Relations do hereby revoke the exemption of work permit issued to Theodosios Monogenis of Consolidated Contractors (PNG) Company Limited under Section 51 of the *Employment of Non-Citizens Act 2007*, as of 31st March, 2013.

- (2) For the company to register all non-citizen employees that require registration with a professional body;
- (3) For the company to provide employment opportunities (decent work, fair pay, promotions etc) to citizen workers;
- (4) For the company to provide opportunities for human resource development and skills training to its employees; and
- (5) Non-English speaking countries to show evidence of English proficiency for applicants.

The Department of Labour and Industrial Relations is satisfied with the training and up skilling opportunities provided by the concern company to its citizen employees and the employment opportunities given to citizen employees.

The exemptions are extensions given to the abovementioned non-citizens in their period of employment to work in country without a work permit for six (6) months commencing from 1st December, 2012 to 1st December, 2014.

In accordance with the requirement of Section 51(3) of the Act I hereby grant approval of these exemptions to the abovementioned non-citizens in the interest of the nation and for a good cause, particularly in view of the LNG Project's significant contribution to the economic, human resource and infrastructure developments in Papua New Guinea.

Specific conditions placed against the exemptions are:—

- (1) The company to pay a fee of K500.00 for each employee (a total of K32,000.00) to the Department of Labour & Industrial Relations;
- (2) For the company to provide employment opportunities to citizens;
- (3) For the company to provide opportunities for human resource development and skills training to its employees;
- (4) The company to have this gazettal notice easily available at the time of work permits inspection.
