Employment of Non-Citizens Act 2007

EXEMPTION NOTICE

I, Mark Maipakai, MP., Minister for Labour and Industrial Relations in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Section 51(1) of the *Employment of Non-Citizens Act 2007* do hereby exempt the following non-citizens employees of Air Niugini the requirement to hold a work permit.

These exemptions are granted in accordance to Section 51 of the *Employment of Non-Citizens Act 2007*. The exemptions are always in the interest of the nation and for a good cause, in particularly, Air Niugini's contribution to the country's development in terms of economic development and up skilling and training of our human resources.

This exemptions are granted from 14th May to 14th November, 2013.

Exemption Notice—continued

Specific conditions placed against the exemptions are:—

- (1) For the company to pay a fee of K500.00 for each employee to the Department of Labour & Industrial Relations (a total of K5000.00);
- (2) For the company to register all non-citizen employees that require registration with a professional body;
- (3) For the company to provide employment opportunities (decent work, fair pay, promotions etc) to citizen workers;
- (4) For the company to provide opportunities for human resource development and skills training to its employees.
