CANCELLED EL 1801 BOUNDARY

CORRIGENDUM

THE Office of the Register of Tenements hereby advises that the original boundary of the cancelled Exploration Licence 1801 is as described hereunder.

The original land area of EL 1801 was bounded by a line commencing at 05 degrees 13 minutes south 143 degrees 46 minutes east then to 05 degrees 13 minutes south 143 degrees 52 minutes east then to 05 degrees 14 minutes south 143 degrees 52 minutes east then to 05 degrees 14 minutes south 143 degrees 54 minutes east then to 05 degrees 16 minutes south 143 degrees 54 minutes east then to 05 degrees 16 minutes south 143 degrees 55 minutes east then to 05 degrees 17 minutes south 143 degrees 55 minutes east then to 05 degrees 17 minutes south 143 degrees 53 minutes east then to 05 degrees 18 minutes south 143 degrees 53 minutes east then to 05 degrees 18 minutes south 144 degrees 01 minute east then to 05 degrees 21 minutes south 144 degrees 01 minute east then to 05 degrees 21 minutes south 143 degrees 46 minutes east then to 05 degrees 13 minutes south 143 degrees 46 minutes east being the point of commencement comprising a total area of 84 sub-blocks with a total area of 287 square kilometres.

The Registrar of Tenements pursuant to his powers under the *Mining Act* 1992 notifies that from the date of publication of this notice, 30 days shall lapse before any new exploration licence applications for this area can be lodged with the Registrar. This notice replaces the notice published in the *National Gazette* on December, 2012. The Register of Tenements has been rectified accordingly.
