*Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002***NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DECLARE GOODS UNSAFE (CERTAIN BABY DUMMIES, SOOTHERS AND PACIFIERS)**

PURSUANT to Section 114(1) of the *Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002*, the Independent Consumer and Competition Commission (“Commission”) proposes to publish in the *National Gazette* a notice under Section 108(5) of the *ICCC Act* in substantially the same form and substance indicated below, declaring the goods described in the notice to be unsafe goods in Papua New Guinea.

The Commission invites any person who supplies or proposes to supply baby dummies, soothers and pacifiers of the kind described in the draft notice below to notify the Commission within ten (10) days of the publication of this notice in the *National Gazette*, if they wish for the Commission to hold a conference in relation to this notice.

[DRAFT SECTION 108(5) DECLARATION NOTICE No. 3 OF 2013 (CERTAIN BABY DUMMIES, SOOTHERS AND PACIFIERS NOT SAFE)*Declaration of Unsafe Goods*

PURSUANT to Section 108(5) of the *Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002*, I hereby declare as unsafe in Papua New Guinea, certain baby dummies, soothers and pacifiers and a person shall not supply goods to be used as a baby dummies, soothers or pacifiers unless:

- the goods is made of non-toxic material;
- the goods contains no sharp edges, or points which could injure a baby;
- the goods is of sound construction such that no part of the good will become detached, torn or broken in use;
- the good(s) is supplied in a closed pack;
- the pack allows the enclosed good(s) to be seen clearly;
- the good has a shield with a minimum width of at least 35 mm;
- the good has ventilation holes as specified below;
- the good has a firmly attached handle or ring of a size and shape that may be easily gripped and removed by an adult from the child in the event a good is taken whole into the mouth,. However, the size of rings and handles must be such that they do not protrude so that if a child falls onto a good, it could be forced into the mouth, e.g. a ring must be hinged so that it folds back onto the shield and when folded does not protrude more than 16 mm from the shield;
- the teat of the good(s) is constructed so that it does not contain flavours/fluid;
- the teat is firmly attached to the shield such that it cannot separate to become a choking hazard;
- the pack shows the name and address details of the PNG manufacturer/distributor and country of manufacture, if not PNG;
- the pack has clearly legible:
 - warning notice that tying dummies, soothers or pacifiers around the neck is a strangulation hazard, i.e. WARNING, Do not tie dummy around Baby’s neck as it may strangle Baby;
 - warning about replacing dummies regularly e.g. 4 to 8 weeks (especially if infants have teeth);
 - instructions to check dummies before each use for damage. Eg. Before each use, pull the dummy moderately and inspect to check for holes, tears, stickiness, a flat teat or other damage. Throw away if damaged;
 - a unique batch number to facilitate recalls;
 - suitable instructions for cleaning and storing dummies, e.g. Before each use Either boil the dummy for 5 minutes in water, or Use sterilizing solution according the manufacturer’s instructions;
- Ventilation holes—The shield of a good shall have two ventilation holes positioned symmetrically, whereby:
 - (i) the cross-sectional area of each ventilation hole is at least 19.6 mm²;
 - (ii) periphery of each ventilation hole is at least 5 mm from the periphery of the shield; and
 - (iii) the distance between the geometric centers of the pair or a pair of ventilation holes is at least 15 mm.

Notice of Intention to Declare Goods Unsafe (Certain Baby Dummies, Soothers and Pacifiers)—continued

Additional holes may be provided which do not meet the above requirements.

Nor shall a person supply a good to be used as a baby dummy, soother or pacifier:

- that has decals, stickers or ornaments such as crystals, beads or “bling” which can detach in use to form small parts, which can be swallowed by a baby;
- where the pack containing the good(s) includes any pin, ribbon, string, cord, chain, twine, leather, yarn or any other means of attachment.

Summary of Reasons

Certain baby dummies, soothers and pacifiers create a risk of choking, strangulation, injury and death, particularly for children under three years old as they have not yet developed the reflex action to cough up objects that lodge in their throats.

The Commission pursuant to Section 114 of the Act invites any person (who supplies or proposes to supply baby dummies, soothers and pacifiers of the kind described in this notice) to notify the Commission within 10 days of the publication of this notice in the *National Gazette*, if they wish for the Commission to hold a conference in relation to this notice.

Subject to the above, any person or persons supplying baby dummies, soothers and pacifiers in breach of this notice, shall be deemed to be in breach of Section 108(1) of the Act and is liable for prosecution pursuant to Division 2—Sections 132, 133 and 134 of the Act with a penalty of up to K100,000.00 or imprisonment of up to 2 years and further, pursuant to Section 111(1) of the Act, action may be taken by the Commission to recall these products. The Commission therefore advises that these products should not be supplied in PNG.

Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002

SECTION 108(5) DECLARATION NOTICE No. 1 OF 2013 (YOYO WATER BALLS NOT SAFE)*Declaration of Unsafe Goods*

PURSUANT to Section 108(5) of the *Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002*, I hereby declare as unsafe in Papua New Guinea, goods known as ‘yoyo water balls’ (and similar products):

- (1) that are toys intended to be thrown and returned to the hand; and
- (2) with an elastic cord capable of extending at least 500 mm in length and usually:
 - (a) with a loop on one end to wear around the finger and soft synthetic object on the other; and
 - (b) may be filled with air or a liquid (such as water or toluene); or
 - (c) contain a novelty feature, such as a flashing light or resemble the form of a cartoon animal.

Exemption

This declaration does not apply to products supplied:

- (i) as outdoor and sporting toys such as a practice tennis ball retained on an electric tension cord intended to be anchored; or
- (ii) as a bat with a ball attached by an elastic cord; or
- (iii) goods known as the “yo-be” sling disc.

Section 108(5) Declaration Notice No. 1 of 2013 (Yoyo Water Balls Not Safe)—continued*Summary of Reasons*

The Cord is made of a rubbery sticky plastic material that can stretch to over a meter in length, and if swung around the head of a child, the cord can constrict breathing and cause choking if wound tightly around a child's neck.

Any person or persons supplying these yoyo water balls in breach of this notice, shall be deemed to be in breach of Section 108(1) of the Act and is liable for prosecution pursuant to Division 2—Sections 132, 133 and 134 of the Act with a penalty of up to K100,000.00 or imprisonment of up to 2 years and further, pursuant to Section 111(1) of the Act the action will be taken by the Commission to recall these products. The Commission therefore advises that these products should not be supplied in PNG.

*Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002***SECTION 108(5) DECLARATION NOTICE No. 2 OF 2013 (TOY-LIKE NOVELTY CIGARETTE LIGHTERS NOT SAFE)***Declaration of Unsafe Goods*

PURSUANT to Section 108(5) of the *Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002*, I hereby declare as unsafe in Papua New Guinea, toy-like novelty cigarette lighters (and similar products), being devices:

- (1) which are intended to produce a flame to set alight cigarette and other combustible materials; and
- (2) whose designs maybe appealing to children under 5 years of age as the designs depict:
 - (a) stylised animals; or
 - (b) cartoon characters; or
 - (c) colours; or
 - (d) scale, typical of toys.

Summary of Reasons

The toy-like novelty cigarette lighters create a risk of fire, injury and death, given that children are more likely to be attracted to these lighters and may believe them to be toys because of their bright colours and toy-like appearance of animals and cartoon characters.

Any person or persons supplying these novelty cigarette lighters in breach of this notice, shall be deemed to be in breach of Section 108(1) of the Act and is liable for prosecution pursuant to Division 2—Sections 132, 133 and 134 of the Act with a penalty of up to K100,000.00 or imprisonment of up to 2 years and further, pursuant to Section 111(1) of the Act the action will be taken by the Commission to recall these products. The Commission therefore advises that these products should not be supplied in PNG.
