REVOCATION OF ACTING APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE COASTAL FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

I, Grand Chief Sir Michael Ogio, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(1A) of the Constitution, Section 31A of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995* and Section 6 of the *Regulatory Statutory Authorities (Appointment to Certain Offices) Act 2004*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, on the recommendation of the Public Services Commission, hereby –

- (a) revoke the appointment of Kevin Kautu as Acting Executive Director of the Coastal Fisheries Development Agency; and
