*Employment of Non-citizens Act 2007*

## NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

I, Benjamin Poponawa (MP) Minister for Labour and Industrial Relations in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Section 51(1) of the *Employment of Non-citizens Act 2007* do hereby exempt two (2) non-citizens of the Daughters of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart from the requirement to hold a work permit.

The two (2) non-citizens of the Daughters of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart wish to continue serving the people of Papua New Guinea through the Catholic Church and would like to continue to do so.

These exemptions granted in accordance with Section 51 of the "*Employment of Non-citizen Act 2007*" are always in the interest of the nation and for a good cause, in view of these non-citizens' contribution to the country's development in terms of social and human resource development.

These exemptions are granted from Monday, 23rd May, 2013 to Sunday and take immediate effect.

*Specific conditions placed against the exemptions are:—*

1. For the organisation to provide opportunities for human resource development and skills training to its employees.
2. To have this Gazettal Notice readily available at all times, and be produced upon demand to an Authorised Work Permit Inspector upon request.
