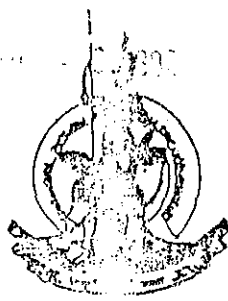

ARRETE

MODIFICATION DU TITRE 1 DE L'ANNEXE DU CHAPITRE 168

1. Dans la colonne 3 du Titre 1 de l'annexe de la Loi (CAP.168) sur la rémunération des dignitaires de l'Etat, désignée dans le présent arrêté par "la Loi", insérer à la fin des mentions correspondant à l'article "ministre" de la colonne 1, la mention "+L".
