## An Ordinance

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Constitution Order, 1920:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Existing Local Laws Continuance Ordinance, 1920.
2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1920.
3. Such of the Ordinances and Regulations of the former Municipality of Apia, of the Ordinances and Proclamations of the former German Government of Western Samoa, of the Proclamations and Orders of the former British Military Occupation of Western Samoa, and of the Tulafonos for the guidance and government of the Samoan people, as were on the 30th day of April, 1920, unrepealed and in force in the Territory shall remain in full force and effect so far as the same are not inconsistent with any Statute, Order-in-Council, Ordinance, Law or Regulation now or hereafter in force in the Territory.
