An Ordinance

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa act 1946

1. Alia Ordinance may be cited as "The Maintenance of Authority in Native Athers Ordinance, 1927."

In this Ordinance "native authority" means and includes any recognised Samoon Chief, any Pulenu'u, Fa'amasino, Pule'a'atosga, or Puiple in the sertice of the Administration of Samoa, any Village Committee or District Council constituted under the Native Regulations (Samoa) Order, 195, and the Fono of Faipules constituted under the Samoa Act 1921.

Every person is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a statement on the exceeding £100 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one members year who originates, repeats or publishes any false report or misleading statement, if such rumour, report or statement is of a nature calculated on likely.

- No prosecution under this Ordinance shall be instituted without Condition of the previous consent in writing of the Administrator or shall be heard save by a Indge of the High Court.
