

I Short title 2. Interpretation

1976, No. 16

AN ACT to amend the Main Roads Development Act 1972.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:-

[17 December 1976]

- 1. Short title-This Act may be cited as the Main Roads Development Amendment Act 1976, and shall be read together and be deemed to be part of the Main Roads Development Act 1972* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 2. Interpretation—Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the definition of the term "Director".
- 3. Alteration of area—The principal Act is hereby further amended by repealing section 6, and substituting the following section:—

"6. (1) The Head of State, acting on the advice of Cabinet, may from time to time by Order add to or reduce the area

or any part of the area.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), no such addition shall include any land that is more than 100 metres in distance from any point of the middle line of the main road included in the area.

(3) Any addition under this section may include any land that is more than 100 metres in distance from any point of the middle line of the main road included in the area, if and to the extent that such land is required for the provision of drainage facilities for that main road.

(4) As soon as reasonably practicable after the making of

any Order under this section-

(a) The Minister shall cause the Order to be published in

the Gazette and in the Savali; and

(b) Where the Minister is able to ascertain the identity and address of a person having an estate or interest in the land affected by the Order, or occupying such land, or of the agent of such person, the Minister shall cause a copy of the Order to be served on every such person."
