## THE OLD VINI ROADS CLOSING ORDINANCE, 1934. Western Samoa No. 7, 1934.



## AN ORDINANCE

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Act, 1921.

## Short Title.

- This Ordinance may be cited as "The Old Vini Roads Closing Ordinance, 1934".
- In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by Section 347 of "The Samoa Act, 1921", and of all other powers and authorities thereto enabling the land mentioned and described in the Schedule hereto is hereby closed as a road.

## SCHEDULE.

- All those parcels or strips of land situate at Vini, near Apia, being Parcels 368/145, 251/145 and 363/145, of Flur I, Upoln, in the District of Tuamasaga, containing together 0 acres of roods 21 perches, more or less, and shown on the plan of Circuit 7, in the Office of the Chief Surveyor, at Apia.
- All those parcels or strips of land situate at Vini, near Apia, being Parcels 398/11, 399/12 and 400/13, of Flur I, Upolu, in the District of Tuamasaga, containing together 0 acres 0 roods 25 perches; more or less, and shown on the plan of Circuit 7, in the Office of the Chief Surveyor, at Apia.
